



Vigilance Awareness Week 2017

Essay Competition for Schools in Ernakulam District

Conditions

1. In connection with the Vigilance Awareness Week–2017 to be held from 30th October to 4th November, it is proposed to conduct an “Ethics Essay Competition” on Sunday, 29th October, 2017.
2. The competition will be held from 11:00 AM to 12.30 PM on 29th October 2017 at FACT Training School, Udyogamandal, Eloor.
3. Candidates should report at the venue by 10:30 AM.
4. The specific topic of the Essay will be given at the Venue. However it will be related to Corruption, Vigilance & Ethics.
5. The Winners will be awarded during the valedictory function of Vigilance Awareness Week–2017 on 4th November 2017 at Udyogamandal Club, Eloor.
6. The Essay writing competition will be open to students studying in 10th, 11th and 12th Standards of all Schools (Government/Aided/Unaided/Private) situated in Ernakulam District.
7. The Essay can be written in ENGLISH or MALAYALAM (but NOT in both Languages by the same student). There are separate Prizes for English and Malayalam.
8. The Essay should consist of not more than 2000 words and not less than 1000 words.
9. The total marks will be 100 with break up as under:

a) Introduction, Presentation, Conclusion, Language, Neatness, etc.	= 25
b) Application of mind on the subject	= 25
c) Originality of ideas /thoughts	= 25
d) Quality of content	= 25
Total	= 100
10. The student will be allowed to participate in the Competition only if presented with the authorization from the Principal/Vice Principal of the school in the prescribed Proforma attached herewith.



11. Each school can nominate a maximum of one student each for English and Malayalam.
12. The student should carry the photo identity card issued by the school for attending the Competition.
13. The participant should come prepared with pens; while the stationery will be supplied by FACT at the venue.
14. No text books, notes or any sort of reference material will be permitted into the competition venue. The participants are expected to display the highest level of discipline in the competition.
15. The Prizes will be as follows; separately for English and Malayalam.

Winner	:	Rs.2,000 and Certificate
Runner up	:	Rs.1,000 and Certificate.
Consolation prize	:	Rs.500 x 4 and Certificates
