- 3.0 **TENDER UPDATES:** Bidders are requested to visit Central Public Procurement Portal (<a href="https://eprocure.gov.in">https://eprocure.gov.in</a>) for any updates/corrigendum on the tender, including extension of due date, if any.
- 4.0 Goods and Service Tax Applicability for Evaluation of Bids:

As per provisions of GST, services of Goods Transport Agency (GTA) in relation to transportation of goods are a notified service under Reverse Charge, i.e., the liability to pay tax is by the recipient of goods/services instead of the supplier. Accordingly, the obligation of remittance of applicable rate of GST is on the recipient of service. i.e. FACT. Therefore the rates quoted by the GTA (Bidder) should be exclusive of GST.

5.0 The list of clusters, the estimated rate and the estimated total quantity of bulk gypsum to be transported from FACT Cochin Division (FACT - CD) at Ambalamedu to various destinations in the clusters of specified districts in South India by road, during the contract period of one year, are indicated in the Price Bid Schedule [Annexure - VIII]. The applicable distances are indicated in the unpriced bid [Annexure - VII]. The distances indicated in the unpriced bid against each district are only the approximate distances for indicative purpose and no claim shall be entertained for variation in the quoted rates due to any variation in the actual distances from the indicated distances.

The contractor will have to transport the bulk gypsum from CD as per our requirement to any destination of specified clusters for which he is awarded the contract and there exists a uniform transportation rate for movement of bulk gypsum from CD to any destination within a particular cluster.

### 6.0 METHOD OF EVALUATION OF BIDS/AWARD OF CONTRACT:

- 6.1 Bids will be evaluated based on the pre-qualification criteria and other requirements stipulated in the tender enquiry.
- 6.2 **Contracts shall be awarded on cluster wise basis**. Bidder shall quote their most competitive rates for transportation of bulk gypsum by trucks/lorries from FACT Cochin Division at Ambalamedu to the clusters indicated in the Price Bid Schedule as per **Annexure-VIII**. **Bidders shall quote the rate only in the Price Bid Schedule enclosed as Annexure VIII**. Price Bids which are submitted in any other format are liable to be rejected.

In the BOQ sheet, the estimated rates are shown for each item (i.e. cluster). The bidder has to enter "Excess (+) or Less (-) percentage" against each item (i.e cluster) they intend to quote in the BoQ. This Excess (+) or Less (-) percentage quoted by the bidder against each item (i.e cluster) will be applied on the FACT's estimate for the respective item(s) of work in the BOQ, and the rate per unit of each item of work quoted by the bidder will be automatically calculated. Evaluation of bids and determination of the lowest bidder (L1) for each item shall be worked out by multiplying the rate per unit of each item quoted by the bidder with the respective quantity given as per the schedule of work given in the Price Bid (BoQ) Format. The technically acceptable bidder who has quoted

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the lowest value in the BOO for an item shall be selected as L1 bidder for that item.

6.3 In case more than one bidder become the L1 to any cluster, based on the evaluation as above, such L1 bidders alone shall be given an opportunity to submit revised lower price bids, if any, in sealed cover on or before the due date and time specified. Instructions stipulated in the tender with regard to submission, opening and evaluation of price bids shall be applicable for such revised price bids. However, while submitting the revised price bid, such bidders shall not increase any of the rates quoted by them in their original price bid

### 7.0 SPLITTING UP OF WORK:

- 7.1 FOR CLUSTERS WITH QUANTITIES UPTO 10,000 MT: For clusters with annual requirements up to 10,000 MT, there shall be no splitting of the order quantity. The entire quantity will be awarded to the successful L1 bidder. However, an MSE quoting in the price band of L1+15% may be awarded for full/complete work of tendered value, subject to matching with the L1 rate, considering the purchase preference as per clause 8.0 of Instruction to Bidders.
- **7.2 FOR CLUSTERS WITH QUANTITIES BEYOND 10000 MT**: Considering the nature of work and to have flexibility in movement operations, FACT proposes to engage more than one contractor for transportation to clusters with annual requirements beyond 10,000 MT.

If a non MSE bidder becomes lowest (L1), then 25% of total order quantity shall be allocated to lowest quoted MSE bidder as per the clause 8.0 of Instruction to Bidders, based on matching with L1 quoted rate.

For the balance quantity, the lowest bidder (L1) and the second lowest bidder (L2) will be awarded order in the percentage ratio of 70:30 of the balance quantity subject to matching with the L1 rate.

If MSE bidder becomes lowest bidder (L1), 70% of the work will be awarded and in this case the preference to MSE bidder as per the clause 8.0 of Instruction to Bidders will not be applicable.

In case L2 does not match with the L1 rate then L3 will be awarded order allocated for second lowest bidder subject to L3 matching with L1 rate and so on. The opportunity shall be extended to all eligible bidders who qualify the PQ criteria until 2 bidders are shortlisted for placing of orders. In case L2, L3 etc. do not match with the L1 rate, order may be given to L1 for the full quantity.

- 7.3. Decision of FACT on splitting order shall be final and binding on the bidders. Tendered quantity shall be split between the bidders only after considering the benefits applicable to the MSE bidders.
- 8.0. Any tender i) Which varies from our terms & conditions or stipulates counter conditions, OR ii) Which fails to provide required information or is otherwise incomplete, OR iii) Which is received from a Registered Fertilizer dealer or their partners or persons having implicit or explicit relations with the dealer or employee of FACT is liable to be rejected.

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- 9.0 The acceptance of tender will rest with the company, which does not bind itself to accept the lowest tender and reserves to itself the right:
  - i) To reject any or all tenders.
  - ii) To finalize the contract based on revised lower rates to be obtained from the L1 bidders in case more than one bidder becomes L1 to any destination.
  - iii) To award the work in part and not in its entirety, if considered expedient, without assigning any reason or giving any explanation thereof.
  - iv) To negotiate with one or more tenderers for revision of rates downwards if FACT feels that rates so received are not appropriate.
  - v) To reject the tender of any black listed transporters due to unsatisfactory performance, forfeiture of EMD or due to any other reasons.
  - vi) The financial or business association with FACT fertilizer dealer OR with FACT employee is liable for disqualification.
  - vii) When tenders are received from any proprietorship/ firms/ companies, having one or more common business facilities such as Telephone, fax, emblem, address etc, such tenders shall be considered as having been received from only one tenderer in different names and the lowest acceptable quotation of such common firm shall be considered from the suitable parties.

### 10.0 Rates:

Bidders shall quote their lowest competitive rates for transporting per MT of bulk gypsum for each cluster which comprises of multiple destinations. The rate quoted for a cluster shall be applicable for all the destinations within the cluster for which bidding is done. For example: AP01 is a cluster in Anantapur district of Andhra Pradesh. This comprises of two destinations namely Anantapur and Singanamala Mandal which are located within 740-770 KM's from FACT-CD. The bidder shall quote his best rate for AP01 which shall be applicable for delivery of material at all the two destinations.

The rates quoted by the bidders shall be for transport of bulk gypsum by Trucks/Lorries from FACT -CD to various destinations of specified Clusters listed in Price Bid Schedule-BOQ Excel Sheet (Annexure- VIII) as per Notice Inviting Tender, Instructions to Bidders and Terms and Conditions of this tender. The rates shall be quoted only as per the Price Bid Schedule -BOQ Excel Sheet attached as Annexure- VIII.

The rates shall be for transport of bulk gypsum by trucks/lorries only and shall not include charges towards loading at FACT. Loading of gypsum at CD shall be arranged by FACT whereas the unloading at various destinations will be under the scope of the respective customer. The rates shall be firm during the period of contract.

11.0 A declaration is being obtained from the bidder with respect to proprietor or one or more partners having financial interest or sharing of common business facilities with registered Fertilizer Dealer of FACT. The bidder in such case will be permitted to have one of the following businesses a) Transport contractors b) Dealership. If the bidder is suitable as a transport contractor, all the issues need to be settled before termination/ suspension of

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other businesses as mentioned above. If the facts of such common business is established at a later stage, all such contract/ contracts are liable to be terminated.

### 12.0 Declaration of Tenderer's relation with FACT Employees:

Should a tenderer or contractor have a relation or relations or in the case of firm or Company of contractors, one or more of its shareholders or a relation or relations of shareholder with an employee of FACT in the capacity of junior Officer and above, the authority inviting tender shall be informed of the fact at the time of submission of the tender, failing which the Company may at its sole discretion, reject the tender or rescind the contract.

- 13.0 If any information given is found to be untrue, FACT reserves right to terminate the contract without any notice or assigning any reason thereof.
- 14.0 At the time of submission of tender, the Contractor shall submit a declaration stating whether the Proprietor, Director, Partner, as applicable, of his firm is having any relations with any Proprietor/ Director/Partner of any registered fertilizer dealership firm of FACT fertilizers. Also, in case, during the validity of contract such relationship is established subsequently, FACT will have to be informed of the same and contract will be liable for termination with immediate effect.

### 15.0 **GENERAL**

- 15.1 When bids are received from any proprietorship /firm/ company having the same proprietor or one or more partners / directors in the business organisation of any other party (hereinafter called Common Firms), such bids shall be considered having been received from only one applicant in different names and the lowest acceptable quotation of such Common Firm shall only be considered for award of contract.
- 15.2 FACT also reserves the right to reject any or all bids without assigning any reasons whatsoever, and / or based on the past unsatisfactory performance by bidders at FACT / other PSEs / Govt. Departments. The opinion of FACT regarding the same shall be final and conclusive.
- 15.3 FACT Dealers shall not be permitted to work as our Transport Contractor also. If a Dealer is suitable as a transport contractor, all the issues need be settled before termination / suspension of Dealership.
- 15.4 Bids from bidders against whom any criminal case, enquiry or investigation/report by authorities like Vigilance, CBI etc., are pending in relation with FACT or bidders who are defaulting contractors of FACT shall be disqualified and rejected.
- 15.5 **Integrity Pact:** The bidders shall sign and submit an "Integrity Pact (IP)" to be executed between the bidder and Fertilisers and Travancore Ltd. along with the bid as per Annexure-XI. IP shall be implemented through the following Independent External Monitors (IEMs) for the bid.

# **INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS**

- 1.0 Bidders shall study carefully the complete tender documents viz. NIT with Prequalification criteria, Instructions to Bidders (ANNEXURE-I), Technical Procurement Specifications if any, Terms & Conditions and any other documents forming part of this tender attached herewith. All conditions set out there in shall be binding on the bidders unless conflicting with any conditions expressly stated by FACT while accepting any bid in the event of such acceptance. One signed and scanned copy of the above documents shall accompany their online bids signifying their acceptance of the same. Bidder shall also submit along with his bid Vendor data updation (Declaration) Form, Check list (If applicable) and Compliance Statement duly filled with all details required therein and also attach supporting documents as required.
- 2.0 Before submitting the bid, the bidder shall familiarise himself about the details of the work, operating conditions during different seasons of year, etc., collect all necessary data regarding the facilities available at various points indicated in Special Terms and Conditions, applicable timings, routes etc., and satisfy himself on all aspects relating to this work which he has to handle and execute for the full contract period and shall make due provisions in his rates for any contingency or difficulty involved in the work covered by this enquiry. Depts/firms, public sector units, Micro and Small Enterprises (MSE units) registered under MSMED Act (subject to uploading the copy of latest valid Udyam Registration Certificate along with their bid)/ firms registered under NSIC/Khadi Board etc. as per applicable govt. directions, on submission of valid documents in proof of the same.
- 7.3 If any bidder retracts from or without request of FACT revises or amends his bid during its validity period or fails to submit Security Deposit within the stipulated time or fails to execute the required agreement when the contract is awarded or fails to commence the execution of the work on the stipulated date, the EMD furnished shall be liable to be forfeited without prejudice to FACT's other right to claim damages.

### 8.0 PURCHASE PREFERENCE:

# **Special Terms and Conditions of Contract**

#### 1. Definitions:

FACT shall mean the FERTILISERS AND CHEMICALS TRAVANCORE LIMITED with Registered office at Udyogamandal, Kochi-683501 and its operating Divisions at Udyogamandal and Ambalamedu (which expression shall repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, include its successors and assigns).

"Contractor" shall mean the individual / firm / company, who has been awarded the Work Order (Contract) against his/their bid in response to the enquiry issued by FACT and shall include his/their legal representatives heirs, successors and assigns.

FACT (CD) shall mean FACT's production unit at Ambalamedu and shall be applicable accordingly.

#### 2. SCOPE OF WORK:

Scope of work shall be transportation of bulk gypsum from FACT Cochin Division at Ambalamedu by trucks/lorries with leak proof body to various destinations as specified in the tender from the date of commencement of work as per LOI/Work order, whichever is earlier. The scope of work shall include proper leveling of the heaps of material in the loaded trucks/lorries, covering the material with the contractor's tarpaulins, lashing, placement of the trucks/lorries in any orientation as per the requirement of FACT and weighing of each truck/lorry for every trip for taking tare weight and gross weight both at the dispatching and receiving ends and unloading at customer's destinations as per the tender. The destinations and respective quantities to be transported are indicated in the Price Bid Schedule. The loading of material onto lorries/trucks shall be arranged by FACT. The contractor shall transport gypsum from FACT-CD as per FACT's requirement to any destinations in the cluster for which he is awarded the contract. All loaded trucks/lorries shall be covered with suitable Tarpaulins, irrespective of weather conditions.

The Contractor shall supply sufficient number of trucks/lorries for the work in good working condition & valid documents to commence and complete the work expeditiously and to ensure transportation of cargo in a smooth manner. The trucks used shall be in good service condition, not more than 15 years old.

While transporting, the contractor shall ensure that there is no leak of gypsum through the openings in the truck. Also the material shall be adequately covered so that dust shall not leak from the top. This is to be ensured by the contractor in view of the environmental problems. The contractor shall be responsible for the safe operation as mentioned above and for any fallout arising due to default of the above.

Senior Manager(Marketing)C&C shall be the Contract Administrator for transportation of bulk Gypsum from FACT (CD) as per this contract. The transporter shall receive instructions for transportation from C&C Marketing dept. (Phone- 0484-256 7391/7561).

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#### 3. PERIOD OF CONTRACT:

The period of Contract shall be one year from the date of commencement of work as per Letter of Intent (LOI)/Work Order, whichever is earlier.

### 4.0 CONTRACT RATES:

- 4.1 CLUSTERWISE QUOTE: The bidders shall quote their rates for each clusters which comprises of multiple destinations. The rate quoted for a cluster shall be applicable for all the destinations within the cluster for which bidding is done. For example: AP01 is a cluster in Anantapur district of Andhra Pradesh. This comprises of two destinations namely Anantapur and Singanamala Mandal which are located within 740-770 KM's from FACT-CD. The bidder shall quote his best rate for AP01 which shall be applicable for delivery of material at all the two destinations.
- **4.2 ADDITION OF DESTINATION:** The contractor shall transport gypsum to any additional destinations which falls in the cluster at the same rate for which work order has been awarded, if required by FACT.
- **4.3 TRANSPORTATION RATES:** The rates shall be for transport of bulk gypsum by Trucks/Lorries only and shall not include charges towards loading at FACT. Loading of gypsum at CD shall be arranged by FACT whereas the unloading at various destinations will be under the scope of the respective customer. The rates shall be firm during the period of contract.

### **5.0 SECURITY DEPOSIT:**

The successful bidder(s) shall be required to furnish an interest free Security Deposit (SD) as detailed in clause 2.0 of Standard Terms and Conditions of Contract. However, the contractor(s) shall remit security deposit only after final confirmation from FACT.

### 6.0 COMMENCEMENT OF WORK:

The contractor shall commence the work as per instructions given in the Letter of Intent/Work Order. In case the bidder whose bid is accepted, fails to deposit the prescribed Security Deposit or fails to execute the agreement or fails to commence the execution of the work within the specified time, the contract issued to him is liable to be cancelled and the Earnest Money already deposited by the Contractor (if applicable) shall be forfeited without any further reference to the Contractor and alternative arrangements shall be made at the risk and cost of the Contractor.

### 7.0 VINSLIP:

Entry of vehicles is regulated by online VIN Slip system which permits vehicle entry into company premises for loading of gypsum. On generation of VIN Slip SMS message will be automatically sent to truck/lorry driver's mobile number and he shall report at FACT-CD main gate with the VIN slip message.

At FACT-CD main gate, truck/lorry driver shall show the VIN Slip SMS message to CISF officer in-charge for credential verification & permitting entry. He shall then report to Gypsum dispatch section in PAP-CD for loading gypsum. Truck/tanker driver need not report at C&C Marketing department and shall report directly at FACT-CD.

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VIN Slip shall be booked with the following details:

- a. Loading Request Date
- b. Vehicle Number,
- c. Vehicle Capacity & Requested quantity
- d. Driver Name
- e. Driver Mobile No.
- f. Transporter Name
- g. Driver Hazardous License No. with validity

The scope of booking vinslip tokens using the aforesaid details shall rest completely with the contractor. He shall ensure smooth entry of vehicles with valid vinslip tokens, as per the directions issued from C&C Marketing.

### 8.0 DELIVERY:

**8.1 TRANSIT PERIODS:** Bulk gypsum entrusted with the contractor shall be transported to the destinations as expeditiously as possible and in any case within the following maximum transit periods. These transit periods are exclusive of loading days, Sundays and holidays for delivery at destinations.

**8.2 DELAY IN DELIVERY:** For any delay in delivering the product beyond the permissible/ extended transit period, the Contractor shall be liable to compensate the delay as deemed suitable by FACT. In case the period of delay in delivering the gypsum at destination is protracted beyond one week, the total realizable value and interest will be recovered from the Contractor's bills or any other payment dues to him.

In case the product (gypsum) is held up en-route due to any break-down or accident or Force Majeure conditions or any other reason such as seizure of vehicle by Govt. or Non Govt agencies, the matter shall be intimated to SM(Marketing)C&C, as the case may be over telephone or by email. The contractor himself shall resolve all necessary proceedings if required for incidents related to such issues in transit. In situations that are entirely beyond the control of the Contractor, SM(Marketing)C&C, may, at his sole discretion, permit the extended delivery period of the consignment.

**8.3 DELIVERY ACKNOWLEDGEMENT:** At the destination, copy of the invoice shall be dully signed, stamped and certified by the authorised representative of the customer and shall be handed over to the C&C Marketing Office at Udyogamandal for certifying the freight charges, as per the work order conditions.

#### 9.0 VOLUME OF WORK:

FACT reserves the right to operate the contract completely or partially without assigning any

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reason whatsoever and does not guarantee the quantity to be transported. FACT does not guarantee any continuity of work and the Contractor shall have no right to claim damages including idle time or loss of profit on account of reduction in revenue arising out of variation in quantity made available for transport.

## **10.0 QUANTITY TOLERANCE:**

The shortage/excess will be assessed for the contract period based on the following tolerance:

- **10.1 NON-MONSOON SEASON:** A variation up to 0.5% of the quantity loaded at FACT shall be allowed in the weighment of each Truck/lorry.
- **10.2 SPECIAL TOLERANCE FOR MONSOON SEASON:** A variation up to 1.0% of the quantity loaded at FACT shall be allowed in the weighment of each Truck/lorry for dispatches during the monsoon months of June to September.
- **10.3 QUANTITY DISPUTES FROM CUSTOMER:** In case of dispute in delivered quantity raised by customers beyond the aforesaid tolerance limits, FACT reserves the right to invoke suitable recovery from the contractor to compensate the customers for such shortage of materials.

### 11.0 QUANTITY FOR BILLING:

The contractor shall submit his bills for the delivered quantities as follows:

- a. If the delivered quantity is within the tolerance limit specified vide section 10.0 above, the dispatch quantity from FACT shall be reckoned for accounting and payment.
- b. If the delivered quantity is beyond the tolerance limit specified vide section 10.0 above, the delivered quantity at destination, as certified/acknowledged by the customer or his authorized representative shall be reckoned for accounting and payment.
- c. However, no payment shall be given for net excess delivered.

### 12.0 SHORTAGE/DAMAGE OF GOODS:

The Contractor shall be entirely responsible for the safe carriage of goods and its receipt by the Consignee. Any shortage of the delivered material, beyond the tolerance limit specified vide section 10.0 above, by way of transit loss / damage at the time of delivery of the consignment to the consignee shall be to the contractors account. FACT reserves the right to realize such compensation by appropriating from the Contractor's bills / security deposit and/ or by foreclosing the Bank Guarantee.

### **13.0 CORRESPONDENCES:**

The contractor shall submit a valid e-mail ID to FACT. Any intimation to contractor shall be sent by e-mail to their ID given in application.

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#### 14.0 CONTRACT EXECUTION:

- **14.1 PERFORMANCE:** The Contractor shall undertake transportation on all days including Sundays and holidays round the clock. The contractor is entirely responsible for the safe transportation of the material and its timely delivery at the specified destination. In case of failure by the Contractor to transport the required quantity as per the instruction from C&C Marketing Division, FACT shall have the right to make alternate arrangements to transport the product at the risk and cost of the Contractor with or without cancellation of the contract. FACT may at its sole discretion arrange such alternate arrangement to any particular destination/s from FACT-CD. FACT shall recover all additional costs incurred for such alternate transport arrangements from the Contractor's running bills or from any amounts due to the Contractor.
- **14.2 SUBLETING OF RESPONSIBILITY:** The contractor shall not assign or sublet the contract or any part thereof or allow any person to become interested therein in any manner whatsoever. Any breach of this condition shall entitle FACT to take such steps as may be necessary and also terminate the contract. Such termination shall also render the contractor liable for payment to FACT in respect of any loss or damage arising or ensuing from such cancellation. In the event of sufficient dues not being available to compensate for the above, the contractor shall reimburse FACT for the same by making payment through a Demand Draft.
- **14.3 TRANS-SHIPMENT:** The contractor shall transport gypsum without trans-shipment, except in case of accident with submission of sufficient proof i.e. F.I.R. or GD entry. Failure to comply shall mandate a penalty of Rs.1,000/-(Rupees One thousand only) per truck.
- **14.4 DETENTION CHARGES:** Detention charges for the trucks/lorries at the loading/unloading points or any incidental charges incurred by the contractor for the work shall not be payable to the transporter under any circumstances whatsoever.
- **14.5 INCONVENIENCE TO THE PUBLIC:** The contractor shall ensure by all means that there is absolutely no spillage of gypsum on road or any public places during transit, which may cause inconvenience to the public. In case of an eventuality like above, the contractor at his own expenses shall ensure that the site/road is cleared from all spilled material immediately. If the contractors fail to do so, then FACT shall arrange the same and the cost will be deducted from the contractor's bills.
- **14.6 SUITABILITY OF EMPLOYEES:** The contractor shall only engage drivers with valid heavy vehicles driving license.

### 15.0 LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:

In case of failure by the contractor to transport the required quantity as above, Liquidated Damages (LD) @Rs.25/MT shall be as levied from the contractor for the shortfall in quantity calculated on a monthly basis.

The LD for shortfall in transportation based on the monthly scheduled quantity will be computed by the C&C Marketing department of FACT and deducted from bills submitted by the Contractor or from any other amounts due to the Contractor/s. The cumulative LD calculated as above shall be limited to 10% of the contract value.

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#### **16**.0 **TERMS OF PAYMENT:**

- **a.** The contractor shall submit his bills together with supporting documents such as FACT's Invoice copy duly certified by each customer's authorised representative in acknowledgement of receipt of the material.
- **b.** Contractor shall submit their bills for payment on fortnightly basis.
- **c.** Payment shall be processed, on presentation of the bills to the office of SM(Marketing)C&C for verification, sanctioning of payment and its release through Finance department.
- **d.** Final settlement of contractors bill shall be made after deduction of (1) amounts due from them to FACT on account of shortage / damages / loss to the goods entrusted to them, (2) statutory levies such as Income Tax, TDS on GST etc. if any and (3) any other amount due from the contractor for any other reason. If the amount due from the contractor is more than the amount due to the contractor, the contractor shall arrange to pay the difference to FACT without delay.
- **e.** Payment of bills to the transport contractors will normally be made within 30 days from the submission of bills along with necessary acknowledgement of dispatch documents.
- **f.** Payment shall be credited after effecting all applicable deductions as per terms & conditions of the work order to contractor's bank through NEFT or RTGS. Contractors are required to furnish the following details along with their banker's authorisation letter:
  - i. Bank Name
  - ii. Branch Name
  - iii. MICR Code
  - iv. IFSC code
  - v. Account type
  - vi. Account No.

### 17.0 PRICE VARIATION CLAUSE:

During the aforesaid contract period, increase / decrease in the transport rates shall be applicable if the retail price of High Speed Diesel (HSD) oil is increased/decreased. The revision formula shall be @ 01 paise/MT per KM for increase or decrease of 01 Rs/Litre in price of HSD oil calculated for one way (single) distance only. The revision in the contracted rate shall be calculated in this proportion for the variation in price of HSD oil, averaged for the applicable fortnightly billing cycle period.

Rate revision shall be based on the revised retail price of HSD at Cochin and shall be effective from the date of HSD price variation. The HSD price at Cochin on the date of bid opening [Pre-qualification cum Techno-Commercial Part] shall be the base rate for the above purpose. In case of revisions from the date of bid opening to the date of issue of work order, work order shall be issued after adjusting the rate as per the above formula. The distance (KM) applicable for the above are indicated in the tender (Unpriced Copy of Price Bid). The distances indicated are only the approximate distances for indicative purpose and no claim shall be entertained for variation in the quoted rates due to any variation in the actual distances from the indicated distances.

18.0 No claim shall be made by the transport contractor against FACT due to non-utilization of the whole or any portion of the number of trucks ordered by FACT or for delay in delivering the material thereof, which may be due to any act of God such as flood, tempest,

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earthquake etc or due to any labour disturbances such as strike, lockout, go-slow, or due short-age of raw material or due to any other cause, whatsoever beyond the control of the company where the goods are produced or despatched. In such cases, the time for utilization of trucks provided by transport contractor shall, at the option of FACT, be extended till such time as the normal situation is expected to return.

- 19.0 Global Positioning System (GPS) Facility shall be provided in the trucks for tracking the trucks as per the directives from statutory authorities.
- 20.0 **AGREEMENT:** The Contractor shall execute within 15 days from the date of receipt of Letter of Intent/Work Order, an agreement on Rs.200/- Stamp paper in the pro forma prescribed by FACT and shall bear all expenses incidental thereto.

OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS: All other terms and conditions shall be as per our Standard Terms and Conditions of Contract - Annexure -V. In case of any contradiction between Special Terms and Conditions of Contract - Annexure - IV and Standard Terms and Conditions of Contract - Annexure - V, Annexure - IV will prevail.

The violation of any of the terms and conditions of Contract by the Contractor shall be liable to forfeiture of the Security Deposit and disqualification from further work with FACT without prejudice to FACT's right to avail other remedies.

#### 03. RATES:

The rates shall be inclusive of all incidental and other charges excluding GST which may have to be incurred by the Contractor in execution of the work as per this contract. The rates shall be firm for the period of contract.

Rate revision on account of changes in the price of High Speed Diesel (HSD) oil shall be effected only if specified in the Special Terms and conditions.

### 04. PAYMENT:

Payment shall be effected, on presentation of the bills to the Chief Manager(Fin)-Bills duly certified by the authorised person specified in the special conditions attached. Final settlement of contractors bill shall be made after deduction of (1) amounts due from them to FACT on account of shortage / damages / loss to the goods entrusted to them, (2) statutory levies such as Income

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Tax, TDS on GST etc. if any and (3) any other amount due from the contractor for any other reason. If the amount due from the contractor is more than the amount due to the contractor, the contractor shall arrange to pay FACT the difference without delay.

### **05 QUANTITY**:

Quantity given in the contract is only an approximate indication and FACT does not guarantee the total quantity to be transported. FACT reserves the right to reduce or increase the quantity at any time without assigning any reason whatsoever and does not give any guarantee regarding the quantity. The Contractor has no right to claim loss / loss of profit on account of reduction in revenue arising out of variation in quantity made available for transport.

### 06. CONTINUITY OF WORK:

The contract shall not mean continuity of work for the Contractor. The Contractor shall contact the authorised representatives of FACT for obtaining instructions. The instructions given over telephone have also to be complied with.

### 07. RESPONSIBILITY FOR MATERIAL:

The Contractor shall be responsible for the material entrusted to him and shall compensate FACT for any shortage or damage while the goods are in his custody.

### 08. <u>SECURITY & SAFETY REGULATIONS :</u>

The Contractor shall strictly observe the Security and Safety Regulations of FACT. Any loss or damage incurred by FACT, on account of the neglect or failure of the Contractor or the Contractor's employees, representatives including the crew of the vehicles/tankers to observe the security and safety regulations shall be to the Contractor's account.

Smoking and carrying smoking material (including matches) inside FACT premises is prohibited due to safety reasons and the Contractor shall ensure that his employees, representatives and crew comply with this.

Any damage caused to any of FACT's buildings, equipment, vehicles, crafts etc. and that of any other contractor/s due to the negligence of the Contractor, his employees, his representatives and crew shall be to the account of the Contractor and FACT shall be indemnified and compensated in all such respects by the Contractor.

All precautions in transporting and handling whether stipulated or not shall be adhered to by the Contractor. The Contractor shall exercise care, diligence and promptness in the work and adhere to transport Rules and regulations, statutory obligations and all other Rules and Laws that have a bearing on the work. Any damages/shortages/penalties or any action legal or otherwise arising out of the Contractor's delay or failure or negligence or breach of statutory obligations shall be to the Contractor's account. If any loss/expenditure arising from the breach thereof is not met satisfactorily by the Contractor, FACT reserves the right to withhold payment of bills/Security Deposit and discharge the obligations of the Contractor without prejudice to FACT claiming from the Contractor full value of damages/compensation. The account rendered by FACT in this connection shall be treated as final.

The vehicles/tankers, if any, employed during the course of the execution of the Contract, shall have valid permits for carrying out the intended task.

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Due safety requirements in handling and transporting hazardous chemicals like liquid Sulphuric Acid, Sulphuric Acid etc. filled in tankers, as provided vide Motor Vehicles Act 1988 and the Central Motor Vehicle Rules 1989 and regulations formulated from time to time by the proper authority, shall be adhered to by the Contractor at his own expense. The vehicles shall be legibly and conspicuously marked with an emergency information panel, as applicable, in each of the three places as per Rule 134 of the Central Motor Vehicle Rules 1989. Further any person driving the vehicle employed in the work as per the Contract shall have the ability to read and write at least one Indian language as per rule 9 of the Central Motor Vehicle Rules 1989 and Rules 4 of the Central Motor Vehicles (amended) Rules 1993.

The vehicles shall be equipped with all the necessary safety appliances/equipment for emergency and rescue purpose as stipulated in Motor Vehicles Act 1988 and rules thereto.

#### 09. STATUTORY OBLIGATIONS

The Contractor shall comply with the requirements of all Local, State and Central Govt. Acts, Rules Regulations, By-Laws, Orders etc, in force from time to time and in particular Indian Factories Act, Workmen's Compensations Act, Contract Labour (regulations and abolition) Act 1970, Minimum Wages Act 1936, The Mines Act 1952, The Explosives Act 1884 and all other relevant Acts and Laws as amended from time to time in so far as they are or may be applicable to the execution of works as per this contract.

The Contractor shall obtain at his cost all permits, license and other authorisation, as required for his work, from Govt. authorities. The Contractor shall maintain proper records & registers as required by the concerned statutes and submit them to FACT as and when required.

Proper records of payment of wages to workers/labourers/crew etc. engaged in the work shall be maintained by the Contractor and produced for inspection when required by FACT.

The Contractor shall be responsible for all payments to his workmen including Employees State Insurance and Provident Fund benefits etc., if any, i.e. FACT shall not make any payments to the Contractor other than the rates agreed for the work. All extra payments, if any, to be made to the Contractor's workmen during the course of contract period shall be borne entirely by the Contractor.

The Contractor shall obtain valid registration under the Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 (PF) & The Employees' State Insurance Act, 1948 (ESI) and shall ensure full compliance with the above Acts. The workers deployed by the contractor for the work shall be covered under the Acts. The contractor shall regularly remit the PF/ESI contributions in respect of their employees and file regular returns, as prescribed under the respective acts. The copy of monthly PF/ESI remittance challans along with periodic returns shall be furnished together with the subsequent monthly bills. In case FACT is to incur any expenditure/loss in the capacity as Principal Employer due to non- compliance on the part of the contractor of these Acts, such expenditure/loss shall be recovered from the contractor.

Tenderers shall submit the registration certificate with Labour dept./PF/ESIC if available. If the tenderer is not registered under ESI/PF Act, tenderer shall submit PF/ESI Registration certificate before commencement of work. Failure to produce the original certificates at the stage of starting the work would result in disqualification and forfeiture of EMD and also liable for debarring from participation in future tenders.

The workers deployed by the contractor for the work shall be covered under the PF & ESI Acts. The contractor shall ensure full compliance to the above Acts. The Contractor shall be responsible for making all payments to his workmen, including ESI and Provident Fund benefits etc., as applicable.

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Payment of PF & ESI for the month, both the employer's (in this case contractor) and employee's (in this case workmen employed by the contractor) contributions should be deposited in the bank in the permanent PF code number and challan obtained before the 15th of the subsequent month should be forwarded to the company.

The contractor will, in turn, submit the documentary evidence in support of payment of PF & ESI of each month along with subsequent month RA Bills.

In case the Contractor fails to discharge his statutory obligations leading to a situation wherein FACT is to incur any expenditure/loss in their capacity as the Principal Employer such expenditure/loss shall be realised from the Contractor.

#### 10. <u>CONTRACTOR'S WORKME</u>N

FACT shall have no dealing with the Contractor's workmen or their Union. FACT reserves the right to debar any of the contractor's employees/workmen/crew from entering FACT premises for whatever reason FACT deems fit.

#### 11. DEFAULT:

In the event of failure on the part of the Contractor to execute the Contract to FACT's satisfaction, FACT may, at their option, either recover from the Contractor liquidated damages as prescribed in the "Special Conditions", if any, or at the risk and cost of the Contractor and without prejudice to FACT's other rights as per the Contract, terminate the Contract wholly or partially and carry out the work through other contractors or by themselves.

#### 12. TERMINATION:

If any work entrusted with other contractors by FACT is obstructed by, interfered with or caused to be interfered with by the Contractor, his employees, his representatives or crew, the contract shall be terminated without notice and the remaining work for the unexpired portion of the contract arranged by FACT through others at the Contractor's risk and cost.

The contract can be terminated by FACT with one month's notice at any time during the pendency of the contract.

# 13. FORCE MAJEURE:

Neither the Contractor nor FACT shall be considered in default in the performance of their obligations under the Work Order so long as the performance is prevented or delayed because of Force Majeure conditions like war or hostilities, riots or civil commotion, earth quake, flood or tempest, drought, accident, fire or explosion, labour strike or lock-out or Act-of-God or because of any law and order proclamation, regulation or ordinance of Government or subdivision there of and situation arising out of our plant break downs. Notice of a Force Majeure situation shall be given by the affected party to the other party with in one week of its occurrence. Should such a delay be for more than three months, FACT shall have the right to cancel the Work Order at no charge to FACT and FACT shall be entitled to reimbursement of any amount due from the Contractor.

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#### 14. ASSIGNMENT:

The Contractor shall not assign, transfer or sub-let this work order without the prior written approval of FACT.

#### 15. APPLICABLE LAW & SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES:

In the event of any dispute or difference relating to the interpretation and application of the provisions of this contract(s) between Central Public Enterprises (CPSEs)/Port Trusts inter-se and also between CPSEs and government departments / Organizations (excluding disputes concerning taxation), such dispute/ difference shall be taken up by either Party for resolution through AMRCD as mentioned in DPE OM No. 4(1)2013-DPE(GM)/FTS-1835 dated 22.05.2018."

Or

(II) For contracts other than (i) above:

If any dispute arises out of or relating to or in connection with this CONTRACT, between the CONTRACTOR and the OWNER/FACT, the same shall be amicably settled through mutual discussions, failing which, the unresolved dispute(s) shall be referred to arbitration in accordance with the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, as amended from time to time and number of Arbitrator shall be one. - a) The Bidder(s) / Contractor(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm, offer, promise or give to any of the Principal's employees involved in the tender process or the execution of the contract or to any third person, any material or immaterial benefit which he/she is not legally entitled to, in order to obtain in exchange, any advantage of any kind whatsoever during the tender process or during the execution of the contract.
- b) The Bidder(s) / Contractor(s) will not enter with other Bidders into any undisclosed agreement or understanding, whether formal or informal. This applies in particular to prices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contracts, submission or non-submission of bids or any other actions to restrict competitiveness or to introduce cartelisation in the bidding process.
- c) The Bidder(s) / Contractor(s) will not commit any offence under the relevant IPC/PC Act; further the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not use improperly, for purposes of competition or personal gain, or pass on to others, any information or document provided by the Principal as part of the business relationship, regarding plans, technical proposals and business details, including information contained or transmitted electronically.
- d) The Bidder(s) / Contractor(s) of foreign origin shall disclose the name and address of the Agents / Representatives in India, if any. Similarly, The Bidder(s) / Contractor(s) of Indian Nationality shall furnish the name and address of the foreign principals, if any. All the payments made to the India agent/representative have to be in Indian rupees only.
- e) The Bidder(s) / Contractor(s) will, when presenting his bid, disclose any and all payments he has made, is committed to, or intends to make to agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the award of the contract.
- (2) The Bidder(s) / Contractor(s) will not instigate third persons to commit offences outlined above or be an accessory to such offences.

#### Section 3 - Disqualification from tender process and exclusion from future contracts

If the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s), before award or during the execution of has committed a transgression through a violation of Section 2 above or in any other form such as to put his reliability or credibility in question, the Principal is entitled to disqualify the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) from the tender process or to terminate the contract, if already signed, for such reason.

#### **Section 4 - Compensation for Damages**

- (1) If the Principal has disqualified the Bidder(s) from the tender process prior to the award according to Section 3, the Principal is entitled to demand and recover the damages equivalent to Earnest Money Deposit/Bid Security.
- (2) If the Principal has terminated the contract according to Section 3, or if the Principal is

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entitled to terminate the contract according to Section 3, the Principal shall be entitled to demand and recover from the Contractor liquidated damages of the contract value or the amount equivalent to Performance Bank Guarantee.

# **Section 5 - Previous Transgression**

- (1) The Bidder declares that no previous transgression occurred in the last 3 years with any other Company in India conforming to the anti-corruption approach including Public Sector Enterprise in India that could justify his exclusion from the tender process.
- (2) If the Bidder makes incorrect statement on this subject, he can be disqualified from the tender process and appropriate action can be taken including termination of contract, if already awarded, for such reason.

#### Section 6 - Equal treatment of all Bidders / Contractors / Subcontractors

- (1)The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) undertakes(s) to demand from all subcontractors a commitment in conformity with this Integrity Pact, and to submit it to the Principal before contract signing.
- (2) The Principal will enter into agreements with identical conditions as this one with all Bidders, Contractors/Suppliers and Subcontractors.
- (3) The Principal will disqualify from the tender process all Bidders who do not sign this Pact or violate its provisions.

# Section 7 - Criminal charges against violating Bidder(s) / Contractor(s) / Subcontractor(s)

If the Principal obtains knowledge of conduct of a Bidder, Contractor or Subcontractor, or of an employee or a representative or an associate of a Bidder, Contractor, or Subcontractor which constitutes corruption, or if the Principal has substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal will inform the same to the Chief Vigilance Officer.

## Section 8 - Independent External Monitor/Monitors

- (1)The Principal appoints competent and credible Independent External Monitor for this Pact. The task of the Monitor is to review independently and objectively, whether and to what extent the parties comply with the obligations under this agreement.
- (2) The Monitor is not subject to instructions by the representatives of the parties and performs his functions neutrally and independently. It will be obligatory for him to treat the obligations and document of the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) as confidential. He reports to the Chairperson and managing Director, FACT.
- (3) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) accepts that the Monitor has the right to access without restriction to all Project documentation of the Principal including that provided by the Contractor. The Contractor will also grant the Monitor, upon his request and demonstration of a valid interest, unrestricted and unconditional access to this project documentation. The same is applicable to Subcontractors. The Monitor is under contractual obligation to treat the information and documents of the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s)/ Subcontractor(s) with confidentially.
- (4) The Principal will provide to the Monitor sufficient information about all meetings among the parties related to the Project provided such meetings could have an impact on the contractual relations between the Principal and the Contractor. The parties offer to the Monitor the option to participate in such meetings.

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- (5) As soon as the Monitor notices, or believes to notice, a violation of this agreement, he will so inform the Management of the Principal and request the Management to discontinue or to take corrective action, or to take other relevant action. The Monitor can in this regard submit non-binding recommendation. Beyond this, the Monitor has no right to demand from the parties that they act in a specific manner, refrain from action or tolerate action.
- (6) The Monitor will submit a written report to the Chairman and Managing Director, FACT within 8 to 10 weeks from the date of reference or intimation to him by the Principal and, should the occasion arise, submit proposals for correcting problematic situations.
- (7) Monitor shall be entitled to compensation on the same terms as being extended to / provided to Independent Director on FACT Board.
- (8) If the Monitor has reported to the Chairman and Managing Director, FACT, a substantiated suspicion of an offence under relevant IPC/PC Act, and the Chairman and Managing Director, FACT has not, within reasonable time, taken visible action to proceed against such offence or reported it to the Chief Vigilance Officer, the Monitor may also transmit this information directly to the Central Vigilance Commissioner.
- (9) The word 'Monitor' would include both singular and plural.

#### **Section 9 - Pact Duration**

This Pact begins when both parties have legally signed it. It expires for the Contractor 12 months after the last payment under the contract, and for all other Bidders 6 months after the contract has been awarded.

If any claim is made / lodged during this time, the same shall be binding and continue to be valid despite the lapse of this pact as specified above, unless it is discharged / determined by the Chairman and Managing Director, FACT

### **Section 10 - Other provisions**

- (1) This agreement is subject to Indian Law. Place of performance and jurisdiction is the Registered Office of the Principal, i.e. Udyogamandal, Kerala.
- (2)Changes and supplements as well as termination notices need to be made in writing. Side agreements have not been made.
- (3) If the Contractor is a partnership or a consortium, this agreement must be signed by all partners or consortium members.
- (4) Should one or several provisions of this agreement turn out to be invalid, the remainder of this agreement remains valid. In this case, the parties will strive to come to an agreement to their original intentions.
- (5) The Bidder / Contractor signing this "Integrity Pact" shall not approach the court while representing the matters to IEMs and he/she shall wait their decisions in this matter.

Without selecting either of the options it is not possible to go forward to further submission of price bid. Kindly select the locations in "ITE" details link and clearly indicate the places where quoted or not quoted by either choosing "Yes" for "Quoted" and "No" for "not quoted". Suppose a bidder enters "No" against a particular location in the "ITE" details link and quotes a rate in the BOQ Excel sheet, this will not be considered for evaluation. So please exercise enough caution and care while filling the particular window to avoid confusion during evaluation. Please ensure that the locations indicated as Yes/No (for Quoted/Not quoted locations) selected in ITE details and locations indicated as Quoted/Not quoted in the un priced copy of price bid format and BOQ are the same.

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
