INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

- 1.0 Bidders shall study carefully the complete tender documents viz. NIT, Instructions to Bidders (Annexure-I), Scope of work (Annexure I-A), Pre-Qualification Criteria (Annexure-II) and Terms & Conditions (Annexure-V), attached herewith. All conditions set out therein shall be binding on the bidders unless conflicting with any conditions expressly stated by FACT while accepting any bid in the event of such acceptance. Bidder shall also submit along with their bid Vendor data updation (Declaration) Form (Annexure III) and Check list (Annexure -IV) and Compliance Statement (Annexure VI) duly filled and digitally signed with all details required therein and also attach supporting documents as required.
- 1.1 Offers against this NIT shall be submitted online on e-Tendering portal https://e-procure.gov.in, with valid digital signature certificate. Offers submitted on any other platform or in any other mode or including e-mails, physical offers etc. SHALL NOT be accepted.
- 1.2 All interested bidders are requested to register themselves on the above website with their valid digital signature certificate. 5.2 Part-B: PRICE BID

- 5.2.1 Price Bid i.e. BOQ (ANNEXURE-VIII) attached to tender shall be uploaded after filling all relevant information such as, name and address of the bidder, rates, date, place taxes & duties for each line item.
- 5.2.2 The priced BOQ shall be uploaded strictly in the format attached, failing which the offer is liable to be rejected. Renaming or changing format of the BOQ sheet will not be accepted by the System.
- 5.2.3 Bidders shall quote prices in the BOQ only. Prices indicated elsewhere shall not be considered. No other documents shall be enclosed with Price Bid (BOQ). Tenders not in conformity with the above are liable to be rejected.
- 5.2.4 Bidders shall quote the unit prices in figures strictly in the order of serial numbers and units as per the Price Bid. The rates of all applicable taxes/duties shall be clearly indicated. The prices shall be firm without any escalation on any account till the order is completely executed
- 5.3 BOQ (ANNEXURE-VIII) shall be uploaded only in Part B.
- 5.3.1 Both Part-A and Part-B of the Bid shall be uploaded with all relevant documents before due date & time in the above portal.

6.0 **BID OPENING:**

- 6.1 **Part-A** of the bids of all bidders who submit their Bids as per the instructions by the due date and time as above and which are in conformity with the Enquiry instructions shall be opened online, on the specified bid opening date & time.
- 6.2 **Part-B** Price bids of bidders whose Part-A bids are found acceptable based on prequalification and techno-commercial evaluation only will be opened on a subsequent date. The Price bid opening date/time will be intimated to the bidders concerned.
- 6.3 Bidders shall meet all expenses in connection with submission of his bid, meetings etc.
- 6.4 FACT reserves the right to extend without giving any reason, the last date for submission and opening of bid, but such extension will be duly intimated to those who have submitted online and also published in our website. In case the date of bid opening happens to be a day of strike/ hartal etc. due to any reasons or happens to be a holiday for FACT, declared due to unforeseen and emergency reasons or due to any tech problems, the bids will be opened at the same time on the next full working day
- 6.5 All the pages of the bid document shall be digitally signed by the bidder/or his authorized signatory and stamped with the bidder's seal as token of acceptance of the contents therein for undertaking the work.

7.0 Evaluation of Bids:

7.1 Evaluation Method: The evaluation shall be based on the total value of Contract for Sulphur, Rock Phosphate, Phosphoric Acid, Ammonia and Sulphuric Acid taken together for 2 years. The total value shall be based on the estimated number of activities for 2 years as given in the price bid and the offered rates for each activity offered by the bidders.

8.0 **PURCHASE PREFERENCE:**

- 8.1 This tender shall be based on MSME order dt. 23rd March 2012, and as amended from time to time, pertaining to Public Procurement Policy in respect of procurement of goods and services, produced and provided by micro and small enterprises (MSE), including special benefits to MSE firms owned by SC/ST and women entrepreneurs, on furnishing relevant documents as proof. Declaration of Udyam Registration Numbers on CPPP is mandatory, failing which bidders will not be able to enjoy the benefits as per PP policy. Bidders will get the benefit of PP policy only if they are MSE bidders at the time of submission of their bids, in proof of which latest valid Udyam Registration Certificate shall be uploaded. Bidders may note that failure to update the relevant information within the period specified in the online Udyam Registration portal will render the enterprise liable for suspension of its MSE status, in which case they will not be eligible to claim PP benefits/EMD exemption.
- 8.2 In divisible tenders, participating MSEs quoting price within price band of L1+15% shall also be allowed to supply a portion of requirement by bringing down their price to L1 price in a situation where L1 price is from someone other than an MSE. Such MSEs shall be allowed to supply 25% (or as applicable) of the total tendered value. In case of more than one such MSE, the supply will be shared proportionately (to tendered quantity). Special provisions extended to certain categories of MSEs as per the order shall also be applicable.
- 8.3 In case of non-divisible tenders, an MSE quoting in the price band of L1+15% may be awarded for full/complete work of tendered value, considering the spirit of policy for enhancing the Government procurement from MSEs subject to bringing down of price to L1 by the MSE concerned.
- 8.4 25% of total order quantity shall be allocated to MSE units as per clause 8.1. Two surveyors will be empaneled subject to L2 surveyor matching the L1 rate. Evaluation of bids and determination of the L1 bidder shall be based on the lowest total value as quoted in the price bid format. The lowest bidder (L1) will be awarded order for 60% of the balance quantity of work (after purchase preference for MSEs if any) and the second lowest bidder (L2) will be awarded 40% subject to matching with the L1 rate. In such a case, during work execution, the job will be entrusted to the two successful contractors on rotation basis. If the L2 surveyor doesn't match the L1 rate the chance shall be given to L3, L4 etc. in this order. If no other surveyor is matching the L1 rate, the entire work shall be awarded to the L1 surveyor.
- 8.5 Purchase preference under Make in India (MII) shall be applicable in the manner specified in the latest Revision of Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order 2017, and amendments thereto, subject to orders issued by Dept. of Fertilisers, Govt. of India
- 9.0 Successful bidders shall be required to commence work immediately on award of contract.

- 10.0 FACT reserves the right to reject any or all bids without assigning any reason whatsoever. FACT's decision in this regard shall be final and binding on the bidders.
- 11.0 Bidders shall meet all expenses in connection with submission of his bid, attending meetings etc. Submission of the bid implies that (a) all the terms and conditions of FACT have been carefully read and understood by the bidder and (b) all the clarifications required have been obtained by the bidder from FACT.

<u>Independent Survey - Scope of Services</u>

A. Bulk Shipments: Sulphur and Rock Phosphate.

- i) Initial and final Draft Survey.
- ii) Interim Draft-Survey if required.
- iii) Hatch Survey if required (to ascertain balance cargo if any or between deck cargo if loaded).
- iv) Drawing of Composite Samples of Sulphur / Rock Phosphate
- v) Chemical Analysis of Sulphur / Rock Phosphate (including Sieve Analysis).

B. Liquid Tankers: Phosphoric Acid, Sulphuric Acid and Ammonia.

- 1.1 'FACT' shall mean the FERTILISERS AND CHEMICALS TRAVANCORE LIMITED with Registered office at Udyogamandal, Kochi-683501, its operating Divisions at Udyogamandal and Ambalamedu and FACT Engineering Works, Palluruthy, Marketing offices spread across South India & FACT Engineering & Design Organization, Udyogamandal (which expression shall repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, include its successors and assigns).
- 1.2 'Contractor' shall mean the individual / firm / company, who has been awarded the Work Order (Contract) against his/their bid in response to the enquiry issued by FACT and shall include his/their legal representatives heirs, successors and assigns.

2.0 **SCOPE OF WORK**

As described in the Scope of Work ANNEXURE -IA.

3.0. Contractor to Execute Agreement:

- ix) Promise, offer or give any bribe, commission, gift or advantage whether himself or through his partner, agent to any officer or employee of FACT or to any person on his or on their behalf in relation to the execution of this or any contract with the company, then and in any of the said cause, the competent authority of FACT may serve the contractor with a Notice in writing to the effect. If the contractor does not within 7 (seven) days after the delivery to him of such notice, proceed to make good his default, in so far as the same is capable of being made good, and carry on the work or comply with such directions as aforesaid to the entire satisfaction of FACT, the company shall be entitled after giving 48 hours' notice in writing under the hand of competent authority of FACT, to remove the contractor from the whole or any portion or portions (as may be specified in such notice) of the works, without thereby avoiding the contract or releasing the contractor from any of his obligations or liabilities under the contract and adopt any or several of the following courses-
