

#### SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PURCHASE

#### **1. SCOPE OF WORK**

Supply of Micro processor/ Micro controller based SO2 Gas analyser single channel Hot Extractive type at FACT Udyogamandal Division as per Technical Specifications, terms and Conditions of tender. This is a process critical item and required for the safe & continuous operation of the Process critical plant.

Quoted analyser shall be suitable for Mounting in Panel with Dimensions 600mm x 600mm (W X D)

# 2. SITE

Delivery of the item is required at FACT Udyogamandal Division, Kochi.

# **3. TERMS OF PAYMENT:**

100% of the supply value will be paid within 30 days after receipt and acceptance of the supplies at site.

# 4. SECURITY DEPOSIT:

The Bidder shall, within 15 days of receipt of order, furnish towards security for faithful performance of ORDER a cash deposit or a Bank Guarantee for a value equal to 3% of the ORDER Value in the Proformaattached.

# 5. EVALUATION OF PRICES & LOADING:

The total cost for supply along with applicable P&F, freight charges, taxes, loadings if any, etc. will be evaluated to arrive at the lowest offer and order will be placed on the lowest bidder(Among the prequalified technically acceptable offers).

#### 6. PERFORMANCE BANK GUARANTEE:

Bidder shall submit Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) for an amount equivalent to 10% of the total order value as per the relevant formats attached and shall be issued/ confirmed by a nationalized/scheduled Bank in India.

#### 7. TEST CERTIFICATES AND DRAWINGS:

Detailed catalogue/ Drawing shall be submitted along with Technical offer. Test & calibration certificates shall be submitted along with supply

# 8. BID SECURITY DECLARATION:

Bids must be supported by a Bid Security Declaration in lieu of Earnest Money Deposit. Only those bids accompanied by bid security declaration shall be considered for evaluation.

# 9. ORDER OF PRECEDENCE
