



ANNEXURE TO NIT: MM/172/E28680 dt. 15.12.2023
SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. SCOPE OF WORK

- 1.1) The selected bidder shall be responsible for supplying the kisan drone, appropriate spares, appropriate batteries, charger and other relevant equipment known as a 'drone pack'.
- 1.2) The selected bidder shall be expected to assume responsibility for the complete management of the drone supply, including transportation to the location, and maintenance of the drone during the Warranty Period.
- 1.3) The selected bidder shall deliver the drones as per the schedule in the bid document. The bidder shall solely be responsible for complying with all applicable rules and regulations and shall undertake to follow the law.
- 1.4) Drone supplier shall arrange training of pilots as well with following condition:
- (i) Approved Training centres (RTPO) in States like Kerala, Karnataka and Tamil Nadu will be finalized by FACT.
 - (ii) Supplier has to make all necessary arrangement for training and obtained pilot license as per DGCA guideline for selected beneficiaries as advised by DoF.
 - (iii) 5 days mandatory drone pilot training and 10 days training for agricultural purpose of nutrient and pesticides application shall be arranged by bidder.

Note: 1. Training can be immediately started after the placement of Order.

2. Charges for Pilot training shall be quoted separately in the Price Bid, excluding Boarding and Lodgings of the Trainers.

2. DELIVERY PERIOD

The bidders must deliver the entire quantity of drones within 3 weeks of the date of award of the contract.

3. PAYMENT TERMS

- 3.1) 80 % payment of supply shall be made on receiving the Drones at the site (as mentioned in the work order), after submission of the invoices uploaded on the GST portal.
- 3.2) 10 % payment of the supply shall be made within 30 days after all Drones against a particular delivery point are delivered, installed, the payment will be released upon submission of the bills uploaded on the GST portal, duly verified by FACT official.

- 3.3) The remaining 10 % payment of the supply shall be made after the issuance of the completion certificate by Management and receipt of Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) amounting to 10 % of the total order values per the terms and conditions.
- 3.4) Payment of the Training : After the completion of the training of the Nominated trainees and completion of supply order against invoice certified by the FACT official.
- 3.5) Payment under Clause No.3.2 & 3.3 shall be payable only after the completion of the Pilot Training of the Nominated Trainees.

4. WARRANTY AND GUARANTEE

All the supply components shall bear a warranty period of 24 months from the date of completion of all installations and commissioning of drones, including Training. Any defect arising during the warranty period will be rectified by Vendor at their own cost.

5. SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

- 5.1 The supply of Drone should be as per the Technical Specification for DGCA approved agriculture Kisan Drone.
- 5.2 The minimum quantity offered by any bidder must be 20 Numbers. Bidders offering less than 20 numbers shall be rejected.

6. SECURITY DEPOSIT AND PERFORMANCE BANK GUARANTEES

- 6.1) **SECURITY DEPOSIT:** The supplier shall, within 15 days of receipt of Purchase Order, furnish Security Deposit @ 5 % of the PO Value/ furnish Bank Guarantee as per proforma, attached to the enquiry.
- 6.2) **PERFORMANCE BANK GUARANTEE:** A Performance Bank Guarantee @ 10 % of the total basic order value shall be furnished along with the supplies as per proforma valid for the warranty period with 6 months claim period.

7. STATUTORY OBLIGATIONS:

Bidders must comply with all statutory provisions and fulfil legal obligations under various industrial/labour laws. The FACT Ltd. shall not be liable for any non-compliance by the bidder and any liability arising on the Company's end shall be recovered from the bidders.

The supplier shall comply with all applicable rules, regulations, schemes and notifications in effect including but not limited to Drone Rules 2021, Drone (Amendment) Rules 2022, Drone (Amendment) Rules 2023, Certification Scheme for UAS and any other new rules as laid down from time to time.
