1.0 TECHNICAL PROCUREMENT SPECIFICATION

1.1 ITEM TO BE SUPPLIED

Diesel Hydraulic Shunting Locomotive of Twin Power Pack fitted with 2 Nos of Cummins India diesel engine, 02 Nos of Transmission, 04 Nos Axle drive gear boxes with multiple control unit capable of operating in Tandem Generally with all standard accessories etc. as per Data Sheet & Special Conditions mentioned herein.

1.2. SCOPE

Design, Engineering, Manufacturing / Assembly, painting, testing at manufacturer's works, road/shipment worthy packing, transportation and delivery/ supply to FACT Cochin Division site for an Diesel Hydraulic Shunting Locomotive. The scope of work under this specification also includes complete services for successful commissioning & performance testing at site as well as training of FACT's operating and maintenance personnel. All necessary equipment, instruments, services, and labour required for this purpose shall be within the scope of the Bidder.

Any additional material, parts & services which are not specifically mentioned here, but are required to make the equipment complete in every respect in accordance with the technical specification for safe, trouble free & efficient operation and guaranteed performance, shall be deemed to be included within the scope of this specification.

Supply of maintenance tools for the routine preventive maintenance of the Equipment and Supply of consumables/spares for all preventive and break down maintenance during the warranty period of not less than two years. Sufficient inventory of fast-moving consumables and spares shall be stocked and maintained with FACT to support routine and emergency maintenance throughout the warranty period.

3.0 General terms and conditions:

1. The vendor shall quote the unit price of the equipment along with the prices of essential spare parts and lubricants, with delivery at FACT-CD, Ambalamedu.
 - A. The unit price of the equipment shall be quoted separately.
 - B. The price of essential spare parts required during the warranty period shall be quoted separately.
 - C. The price of lubricants required during the warranty period shall also be quoted separately.

The combined prices of A + B + C will be considered for bid evaluation during the tendering process. All packing and forwarding charges, delivery charges, and applicable taxes and duties shall be clearly specified.

2. Vendor may please note that the item is for critical application and their reliable operation is essential. Offers only from manufacturers of reputed make with proven technology for manufacturing such items will be considered for evaluation.

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4.0 SPECIAL CONDITIONS

(Vendors are requested to confirm the following each and every points)

1. All necessary auxiliaries and safety gadgets should be fitted in the shunting locomotive for efficient and trouble free operations.
2. The Loco shall be supplied with separate Diesel Tanks (on top), either side of the Engine in order to facilitate gravity feeding of diesel.
3. The spares such as filters, electrical components, drive belts, cardan shafts, etc., required for normal and trouble-free operation shall be quoted separately as per Annexure A. These spares are in addition to those supplied by the vendor during the warranty period.
4. In the transmission Control System, necessary circuit to be provided for disengaging the Transmission when brakes are applied during Shunting Operation to reduce fatigue in the drive line and axle gearbox.
5. All special tools and tackles required for the maintenance of the locomotive shall be supplied free of cost. (A detailed list of tools and tackles will be enclosed along with the offer.)
6. The necessary drawings, technical brochures, and literature containing complete technical details and features of the transmission system, axles, axle drive gearboxes, hydraulic and pneumatic systems, and brake system shall be submitted along with the offer.
7. Manufacturer's Test Certificates for the locomotive / components are to be submitted along with the item (list of all items for which test certificate will be submitted shall be attached along the offer).
8. The equipment shall be painted with two coats of anti-corrosive primer followed by two coats of anti-corrosive epoxy paint of an approved make and quality, suitable for locomotives and conforming to Indian Railway specifications. Standard markings shall be provided as per Railway norms. The details of the paint used shall also be provided.
9. Our representatives or an authorized third party shall have access to the manufacturer's premises during the execution of the order for inspection purposes. They shall also have unrestricted access at all times to the works and all other locations where materials are being manufactured. The Bidder shall provide full cooperation and all necessary facilities to the purchaser's representatives for inspection of the Bidder's works, raw materials, and the manufacturing process of all accessories, as well as for conducting the required tests as specified herein. The equipment shall be shipped only after a successful Pre-Dispatch Inspection (PDI) by FACT (CD) or its authorized representative.

10. The equipment shall be under warranty for trouble free operation / performance for a period of 24 months from date of commissioning or 6000 hrs, whichever is earlier supported by 10% Performance Bank Guarantee. The warranty offered should be for the whole equipment and separate warranty offered by manufacturer of individual components is not acceptable. Warranty of individual components is acceptable if the period is more than the warranty period of whole equipment.

11. Commissioning: All spares and lubricating/hydraulic oils required for the commissioning of the equipment shall be supplied by the manufacturer at no additional cost. The equipment should be commissioned at FACT Cochin Division free of cost.

12. The Supplier shall provide comprehensive training on the operation, routine maintenance, safety procedures, and general upkeep of the machine to the Purchaser's designated operators and/or maintenance personnel at the Purchaser's site, free of cost.

13. Maximum Haulage Capacity of the Equipment offered by the vendor is to be tested at FACT - Cochin Division Site with Loaded Wagons in presence of Inspection, user and Maintenance dept. Officials and Vendors Personal's.

14. Shunting Locomotive shall be marked with manufacturer's brand name, model no. and capacity. Additionally, all lubrication points shall be provided with nipples / cups complying with the relevant standards and FACD CD name with FACD logo on both sides of cabin to be produced by writing or brass punch plates.

15. The vendor shall ensure service support and the supply of spare parts for a minimum of 20 years from the date of equipment commissioning. Spare parts list indicating Part No. shall be furnished along with the equipment. For smooth and effective service, a local service Centre in Cochin is preferred. Alternatively, the vendor's service Centre should be located within South India to ensure timely availability of spare parts and service support for the equipment and its sub-assemblies. The vendor shall also provide detailed information regarding the service centres or support facilities available in Cochin or elsewhere in South India for after-sales support.

17. Any modification proposed by Indian Railways, at any stage till commissioning & acceptance of the LOCO will have to be carried out by the Vendor without any extra cost.

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18. Normal working conditions may be taken as dusty and all the electrical gadgets to be suitably covered and protected.
19. Three set of hard copies of Care and Operational Manual, operator instructions handbook, shop Manual and Spare Parts Catalogue to be provided free of cost along with the Equipment. The Operation and Maintenance Manual shall include comprehensive information detailing testing procedures, Hydraulic and Electric circuit diagrams, operation guidelines, Preventive maintenance and Troubleshooting details and maintenance procedures for the equipment. Each manual shall also incorporate a complete set of drawings along with applicable test certificates. Soft copy in PDF formats for all documents shall be submitted.
20. The successful Bidder shall keep the Purchaser informed in advance of the time of starting and of the progress of manufacture of equipment in its various stages so that arrangements could be made for inspection.
21. The Equipment or any material shall not be dispatched from its point of manufacture unless the material has been satisfactorily inspected and tested.
